

"Annual reports.

61 (1) The Director shall, within three months after the end of each financial year submit to the Board for its approval an annual report of the activities, operations, property and finances of the Agency for that year.

(2) Subject to subsection (1), the report shall include a copy of the audited accounts of the Agency together with the audit report on the accounts.

(3) A copy of the annual report approved by the Board shall be submitted by the Board to the President not later than six months after the end of the year to which it relates, and the President shall, as soon as possible, but not later than one month after receipt of the report cause it to be laid, together with his comments on it, before Parliament";

(o) by the repeal and replacement of the words "Executive Director" wherever they appear by the word "Director";

(p) by the repeal and replacement of the words "Deputy Executive Directors" wherever they appear by the words "Deputy Directors".

THE ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AGENCY
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 2010.

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Environment Protection Agency Act, 2008.

Date of commencement.

ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled.

(f) in section 8 by the repeal and replacement of the word "seven" appearing in subsection (3) thereof by the word "six";

(g) in section 12-

(i) by the repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" appearing in paragraph (a) thereof by the word "President";

(ii) by the repeal of the words "between such bodies and the Minister" appearing in paragraph (b) thereof;

(iii) by repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" appearing in paragraph (k) thereof by the word "President";

(h) in subsection (1) of section 14 by the repeal of the words "and approved by the Minister";

(i) in section 30 by the repeal and replacement of the words "Executive Director" by the word "Board";

(j) in section 31 by the repeal and replacement of the words "Executive Director" by the word "Board";

(k) in section 33 by the repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" by the word "Board";

(l) in sections 42, 43 and 44, by the repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" by the word "Board" respectively;

(m) in subsection (2) of section 54 by the repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" by the word "Board";

(n) by the repeal and replacement of section 61 by the following section:-

1. The Environment Protection Agency Act, 2008 is amended—
(a) in section 1 by the repeal of the interpretation to the "Minister";

(b) by the repeal and replacement of the word "chairman" wherever it occurs by the words "Executive Chairman";

(c) by the repeal of subparagraphs (i), (ii), and (viii) of subsection (1) of section 3 thereof;

(d) by the repeal and replacement of subsection (2) of section 3 thereof by the following subsection:-

"(2) The Executive Chairman and other members of the Board, except the Director, shall be appointed by the President and subject to the approval of Parliament";

(e) in section 4-

(i) by the repeal and replacement of subsection (1) thereof by the following subsection:-

"Term of office 4. (1) The Executive Chairman and other members of the Board except the Director, shall hold office for a term of three years and shall, subject to this Act, be eligible for re-appointment for not more than two terms";

(ii) by the repeal and replacement of the word "Minister" appearing in paragraph (f) of subsection (2) thereof by the word "President";
